Indie release gives Idol's England a reason to fly

He's going down the familiar path of *Australian Idol* finalists – releasing an independent record.

But Dan England reckons he has more grass roots music cred than people realise.

"I did five years of live gigs to get myself established before Idol," he said. "I also did a contemporary music degree at Southern Cross University, which many people don't know."

Despite being grateful to *Idol* for the exposure, England always wanted to go independent.

"I started writing it at Avalon Airport while I was waiting for someone to pick me up. I pulled out my guitar and the riff just came to me," England said.

"It's about the everyday things you go through in a relationship – it's how you want the relationship to be."

England is happy to continue co-writing his own lyrics as well as having some creative control over what he is doing.

England will release *Reason to Fly* on a self-titled mini-album under independent label Jellyfish and MGM on October 14.
